What We Do

Our housing options service offers support in accessing:

- Pathways into temporary or permanent accommodation in the private sector
- Pathways into appropriate supported accommodation
- Help managing the transition from rehabilitation/detox to accommodation
- Treatment services
- Meaningful occupation

Who we help

Our service is here to help adults affected by alcohol or other drug use, from most London boroughs*, who are:

1. Aged 18 years or over
2. Engaged with an alcohol or drug day service or a floating support service
3. Homeless, inappropriately housed or moving on from supported accommodation or residential treatment

- Signposting and referral to other agencies
- Landlord and agency liaison
- Focused casework
- Joint visits to other agencies
- Telephone support
- Bidding support

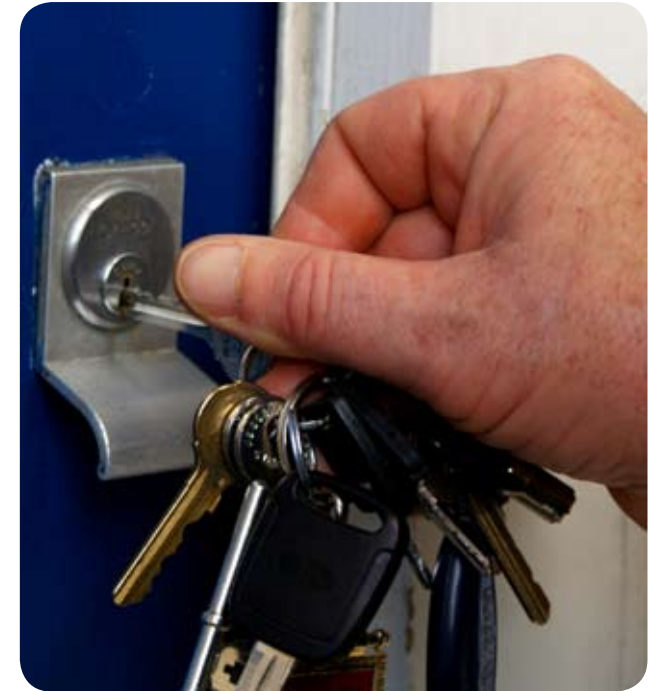
